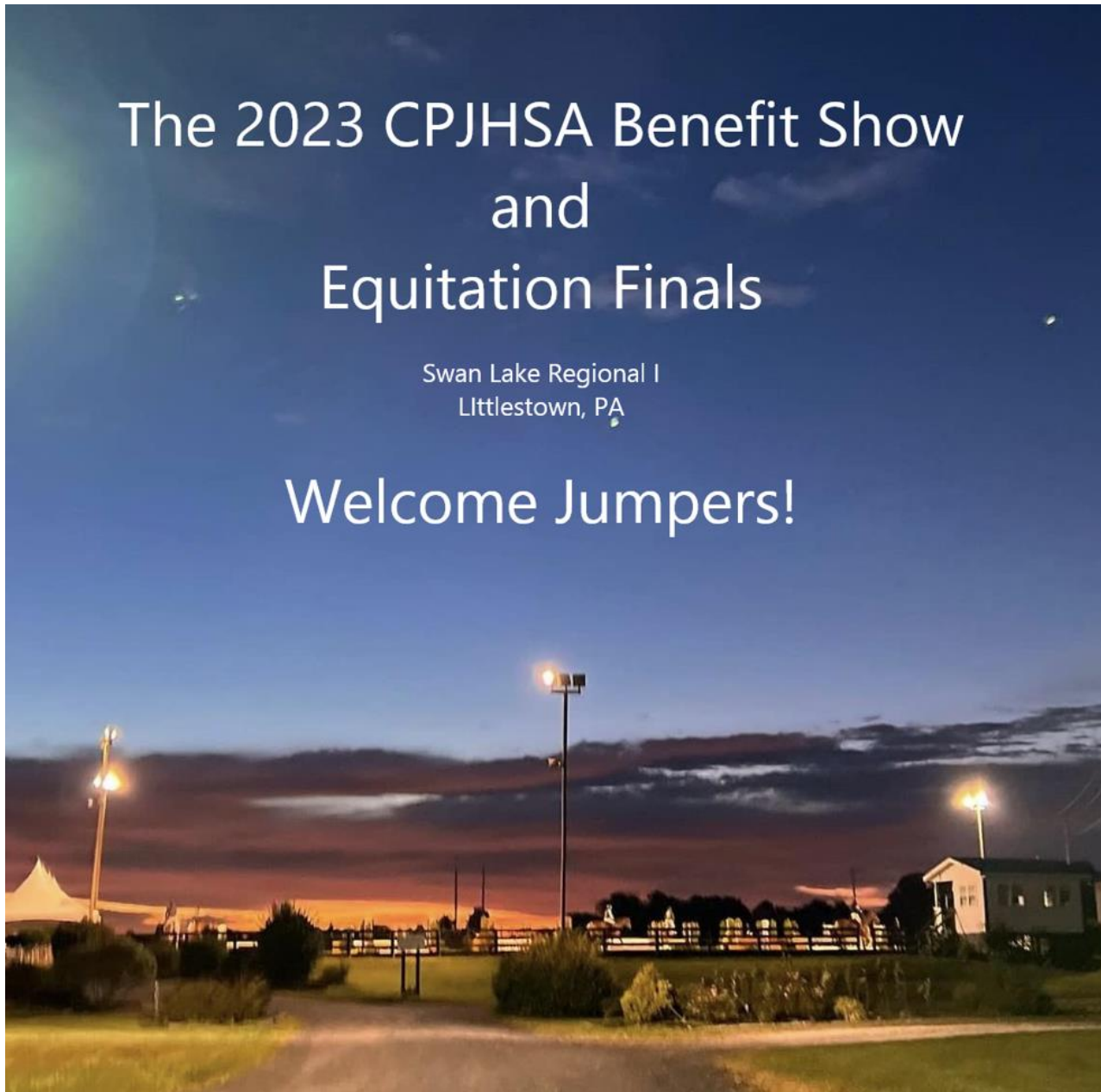

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Entries: Entries will close on September 23, 2023. Entries postmarked or entered online after that date will be considered late entries. Post entries will be charged a late fee \$50.00. Every entry will be charged a \$40 office fee. **NO PHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

STABLING-Stalls are in a permanent facility with doors. Flooring is either matted (main and cafe barn), stonedust (barn #1, #2, and stonedust barn). Stalls are \$125 and are on a first come first served basis. All stall requests must be accompanied by a check and must be received by the close of entries to guarantee that we will have your stalls for you. **STALLS RECEIVED WITHOUT A CHECK WILL NOT BE RESERVED.** Stall fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE.** All horses staying in stalls will be charged a stall fee. Horses under the same ownership are able to share stalls.

SCRATCHES-Horses scratched before the closing date of entries will receive full repayment of fees with the exception of stall fees. **Stall fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.** Horses scratched after the closing date will be responsible for the office fee.

SHIP IN FEE- \$50 will be assessed to every horse/pony not stabled on the grounds.

TICKETED SCHOOLING-\$20 ticketed schooling may be added and will be announced time permitting. Management has the right to cancel due to time restrictions or weather.

NON-SHOWING HORSES-All horses on the showgrounds **must** be registered in the office. Non-showing horses with stalls will be charged for stall fees. Non-showing horses without stalls will be charged a \$50 fee plus a ship-in fee.

ORDERS OF GO- All classes will have a posted order of go. There will be a 2 minute timer on the gate.

CAMPER INFORMATION - Limited Spaces are available at \$175 for the weekend. Charge includes electrical connection and water. No dumping facilities.

VACCINATIONS- This show is compliant with USEF GR848 Equine Vaccination Rule. All Exhibitors must provide documentation to the Show Secretary that all horses on show property have been properly vaccinated to Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus at least 6 months prior to entering the facility.

1. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the USEF.
2. The decision of the Show Committee shall be final in all matters not directly covered by USEF rules.
3. The Management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry, or to return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, rider, trainer, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and all other fees. Every animal entered shall be under the control of the management.
4. The Committee and/or Property Owners and/or Sponsors will assume no responsibility for any accident or injury which may occur to any horse, exhibitor, spectator, groom attendant, animal or equipment at the show.
5. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire with protective headgear in all classes, and while mounted. All juniors must wear approved head protection at all times while mounted.
6. USEF & USHJA membership and USEF & USHJA measurement cards must be shown where applicable, before numbers will be issued. Copies of measurement cards must be included with entry.
7. There must be at least three entries in any class, or the class may be declared off and the entry fee refunded. The committee reserves the right to combine or divide any class or classes should the best interest of the show require it.
6. Championships. In hunter sections, the Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses that have acquired the most points over fences in their section. In addition, only these four horses shall receive full points for the Under Saddle Class. In Pleasure and Short Stirrup sections the Champion and Reserve Champion title shall be awarded to the two horses that have acquired the most points in all classes in their section.
7. All entry blanks must be signed in accordance with USEF Rule V, Section 2.
8. All prize money awarded at the secretary office.
9. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness and emphasis on manners unless otherwise specified.

NO DOGS ALLOWED

It is a condition of entry that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.

WHIPS AND SPURS: Any rider, who in the opinion of the judges, stewards, or schooling supervisors, uses his or her whips or spurs in a cruel or excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class in which the incident occurred and may be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of the incident. In some cases the rider may be barred from further competition if further violations by that exhibitor take place with the same horse or other horses. All fees owed will be forfeited by that exhibitor with no compensation from the show. All incidents will be reported in the Steward's report and reviewed by USEF's Executive Director for further investigation and charges for hearing before USEF's National Hearing Committee.

POLING AND OFFSETS: Manual poling and/or offsets with the use of a bamboo pole or any other device are prohibited at all times. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets, as well as the horse or pony involved, will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred and suspended for a twenty four hour period starting from the time of the incident and will forfeit all entry fees. If further violations by the same exhibitor take place on the same horse/pony or another horse/pony, the exhibitor may be barred from further showing and forfeit all fees due the show.

MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Horse

Show Management. At least one sharps container must be placed in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or any agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. GR1210.4

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. FRIDAY NIGHT COSTUME HUNT TEAMS – 5pm Start Time

Class #500- Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Teams of three ponies/horses, shown over a course in the ring, one to follow the other at a safe hunting distance. Judged on performance, suitability, manners, uniformity and appearance as a team. Teams may pick fence height of 2' or 2'6". Pony/horse and/or rider may only compete on one team. Riders may be juniors, amateurs or professionals. Optional music permitted and submitted by 3:00 pm at the Announcer's Stand. Post-entries ONLY accepted until noon on Friday. Entry fee \$90 per team. Prizes and ribbons awarded to top 6.

Competition Jog: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

HUNTER CLASSICS

Must have entered, shown, and completed at least two over fences classes in the same division at the same show. For all Classics, the 3rd over-fences class of the division will count as the first round of the classic, with the top twelve scores returning to jump a second course. Hunter Classics will run in accordance with USEF Rules and USHJA Zone Specifications. Must have 6 entries to run.

Jumpers must be recorded with the Federation in order to receive points toward any USEF or USHJA Zone or Horse of the Year awards. Any change of a recorded horse's name and/or ownership must be recorded with the Federation in accordance with GR1105 and GR1107. No poling per USEF rules. Schooling will be allowed during the horse show in designated jumper schooling areas only. In the event of a tie, there will be a jump off for first place only. All other ties will be broken by time and faults in the first round, unless otherwise specified.

USEF Motorized Vehicle Rule

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempt from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
